

The Sermon

#### The Vows

N and N, I now invite you to join hands and make your vows in the presence of God and in the company of your family and friends. The Couple may say their own vows or use one of these forms

I A, ask you. B, to be my life-partner,
I B, ask you. A, to be my life-partner,
the companion of my days.
I promise to make a home with you
where love can deepen
and each can grow freely.
I will bear your burdens
and share your joys and sorrows.

I will be family to you through the weathers of time and change. I will honour your work and nourish our life together. I will be tender with your wounds (or frailty) and compassionate in failure, for I, too, come in need of compassion. In the presence of God I make this vow.

A, will you take my hand
B will you take my hand
and be joined to my heart
and stay with me while we grow older,
until death parts us?

Each says to the other:

I will.

(or)

N and N have chosen to speak their commitment to each other using the words of Ruth to Naomi (Ruth 1.16-17):

One says and then the other repeats:

Wherever you go I will go, and wherever you stay I will stay. Your people shall be my people and your God my God. Where you die, I will also die, and there I will be buried with you. May nothing but death part us, by God's help.

# **Blessing of the Rings**

The ring is a symbol of eternity. The circle also symbolizes whole. mess and the wheel of the year as the seasons of life move round For this reason we bless rings.

God, who encircles us all, bless these rings, as a symbol of unending love and faithfulness. May they remind N and N of the vows they have made this day, a sign of the holy bond between them.

Amen.

Each says to the other:

N, I give you this ring as a sign of our union.

I pledge to you all that I have and all that I am within the love of God, Creator, Christ and Comforter.

#### The Proclamation

N and N, In the presence of God, the One Spirit, who joins every living thing, and before this community gathered here you have spoken your vows to each other, , you have joined hands and given and received rings and set a seal on your love now and for the rest of your lives.

# The Handfasting

The couples hands are joined together

The covenant you have made this day is holy and not to be broken. Those whom God has joined together, let no one put asunder.

# **Prayer for the Couple**

The Couple may kneel if desired

Blessed are you, God, source of all love; you created joy and gladness, pleasure and delight. Pour your generous blessings on N and N and may the light of your presence shine softly on their path. May they walk gently through the earth and trust the Spirit to guide their feet. Warm their hearth with stories and laughter and comfort them when dark shadows fall. As they pass through the doorway of this hallowed day, may you, O Christ, bless them with a love that deepens with giving and widens with sharing. And when the lights go down on the world, may they always find in each other a home to welcome them, and so dwell in your peace and plenty all the days of their life. **Amen.**
